<b>1) Tolerance, as defined by either of the following:</b> <b>a) A need for increased amounts of the substance to achieve desired effect OR</b> <b>b) markedly diminished effect with continued use of the same amount of the substance</b>			
<b>2) Withdrawal, as manifested by either of the following:</b> <b>a) Characteristic withdrawal symptoms observable and reported OR</b> <b>b) the same amount of the substance (or a closely related substance) is taken to relieve or avoid withdrawal symptoms</b>			
<b>3) The substance is often taken in larger amounts or over a longer period of time than intended</b>			
<b>4) There is a persistent desire or unsuccessful efforts to cut down or control substance use</b>			
<b>5) A great deal of time is spent in activities necessary to obtain the substance, use the substance, or recover from its effects</b>			
<b>6) Important social, occupational, or recreational activities are given up or reduced because of substance use</b>			
<b>7) The substance use continues despite knowledge of having a persistent or recurrent physical or physiological problem that is likely to have been caused or exacerbated by the substance</b>

If no shaded boxes are checked and patient meets criteria for diagnosis of substance dependency (3 or more on section I), call Acadia Hospital Access Center (973-6048) and fax copy of checklist to 973-6107 and ask patient to arrive at Acadia for evaluation/admission to substance abuse services at 7:30 am any week day.</b>
